Guidelines

Sydney Loofe was raised in Neligh, Nebraska. She moved to Lincoln, Nebraska after high school. She was reported missing on November 16, the day after she went on a date with someone from Tinder. Her body was found 19 days later in a rural area in Clay County. The tragedy took Sydney from her friends and family much too soon. George and Susie Loofe, parents of Sydney, decided to partner with us and advocate for the cause to prevent situations like this from happening, teaching the community how to recognize when there could be malicious intent involved when communicating with others. This scholarship is presented by The Set Me Free Project in honor of Sydney Loofe and her family.

Eligibility and Dates

Applicants to the Sydney Loofe Memorial Scholarship must:

- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Demonstrate plans to attend an institution of higher learning in the areas of sociology/criminal justice, social work or cyber safety.
- Eligible High Schools: Nebraska High Schools (Public or Private)
- Deadline: February 15, 2019 by 5:00 PM
- Award Amount: \$3,000

How to Apply

- Students should attach their resume. Optional additional attachments of activities page or list of awards is also accepted.
- Please attach your transcript.
- A complete application will include a cover page with your name, school, desired undergraduate degree, email address and home address.
- Please pay attention to the essay guidelines, as described below.

Additional Requirements

1. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach or supervisor.
 - a. Make sure contact information is included
2. A personal statement of no more than 900 words addressing:
 - a. Leadership ability in student and/or community service
 - b. An outline of school, community and/or church involvement
 - c. Show examples of leadership experiences that have taught you about commitment and dedication
3. The scholarships will be awarded in May 2019. The Set Me Free Project will hold a celebratory event to award the scholarship, and the student receiving the scholarship should attend, family and friends are welcomed.
